All applicants must either be a resident of, or employed in, the states of Massachusetts or Rhode Island.</p> <p>The application will require you to explain why this training is important to you and how you plan to use it.</p> <p>This SNEP Network scholarship program does NOT cover testing and application fees for the Certified Climate Change Professional® (CC-P®) Credential OR the CC-P® Candidate Program. Scholarship recipients desiring to earn professional credentialing or recognition through ACCO (not covered by the scholarship) will be responsible for that program’s corresponding fee.
